The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints has developed a web site to enhance genealogical research.

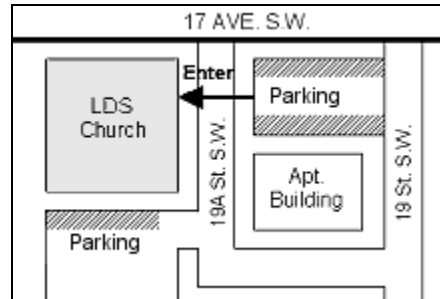

PROCEDURES

- Please register at the front desk.
- Inform a staff member if this is your first visit so they may familiarize you with our services.
- Please come fragrance free.

STANDARDS

- Children under 12 must be accompanied and monitored by an adult.

SERVICES

- **Library** contains a broad collection of books, microfilm, fiche, maps and reference materials to aid in family history research.

- **Readers** for microfilms and fiche are available on a first come, first serve basis.

- **Computers** can be booked in advance. Maximum use is one hour if the Centre is busy. Computer printouts cost \$.10 / page.

- **A Digital Imaging System** is available for making digital images of microfilm, fiche & paper documents. These can be saved in any electronic format (CD, floppy disc, USB stick) or printed which costs \$.10 / page.

- **For Sale (while supplies last):** Disks, research outlines and other materials helpful in organizing your research work.

- **Group Tours** are available by calling the centre.
